ECOH Demographic survey 1999

A survey of all households in Ekhlaspur has been done in 1999. There have a total of 838 households having a total population of 5 285. Data regarding main source of income, house type, drinking water, latrine, union council tax of the households were obtained. Age, education and occupation data were obtained for individuals. Among the health seeking behavior (Table 3) data on birth practice, child immunization were obtained. Data about 147 deaths during five years preceding the interview could be obtained. Only about 7% of people who died could see a qualified doctor before their death. ECOH has started functioning in such a situation where people hardly see a doctor even before death.
